Please submit the following materials:

1. Vita and cover letter.
2. Faculty letter of support.
3. A five page research proposal* written in APA 6th ed. style that includes the following:

- A title page, abstract, introduction, methodology, and selected references.
- 50-word statement indicating how the project will be helped by the grant.
- 50-word statement discussing the project's significance.
- A projected budget and timetable for the project's completion.

*The title page and references are not included in the page count. An appendix up to 3 pages may be submitted with the proposal.
